**ALL VESTED INACTIVE AND RETIRED PLAYERS:**

We are excited to announce a new program under the NFL Player Care Plan ("Player Care") that will benefit many former players – a discount prescription card program. To be eligible for the Player Care card, you must be vested in the Bert Bell/Pete Rozelle NFL Player Retirement Plan and not covered by the NFL Player Insurance Plan.

In a few days Cigna HealthCare will send you a prescription drug ID card. The Player Care card is free, and it does not cost you anything to participate in the prescription drug program. The Player Care card is not insurance. If you have insurance or other prescription drug cards, you must choose which one to use when you fill your prescription.

In addition, your children (if they are younger than 21 years) and your wife can get their own prescription drug ID cards. If you enroll them in the program, Cigna will send Player Care cards to them as well.

Your discount prescription card can be used at more than 57,000 pharmacies in the U.S. – including all major chains, such as Wal-Mart or CVS. By using your card, you can take advantage of significant discounts that Cigna has negotiated with the pharmacies. Although your actual price will depend on the medication and the pharmacy, generally, the discount is about 68% for generic drugs and 16% for brand-name drugs.

Shortly after you receive your Player Care card you will also be sent information about other benefits of using the card – access to www.mycigna.com and Cigna's Healthy Rewards for discounts on health products, services and programs.
